

The First Council of Nicaea (325 AD): A Cartographic Roster of Known Attendees

A Note on the Methodology

While historical tradition holds that 318 bishops attended the Council of Nicaea—a number rich with symbolism—my research into the earliest surviving lists reveals a core of approximately 237 documented names. This project's primary goal has been to create a list grounded in the oldest and most reliable manuscript traditions (Greek, Latin, Syriac, etc.). The gap between the documented names and the traditional number likely represents non-signatories or names lost to time.
