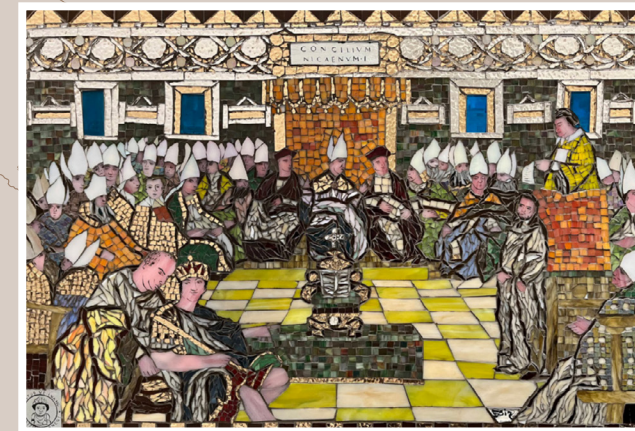


The First Council of Nicaea (AD 325): A Cartographic Roster of Known Attendees

A Note on the Methodology

While historical tradition holds that 318 bishops attended the Council of Nicaea (a number fraught with symbolism), my research on the oldest surviving lists yields a list of approximately 200-300 documented names. The primary goal of this project is to create a basic map of the participants at the Council of Nicaea. The list is based on the oldest and most reliable manuscript traditions (Greek, Latin, Syriac, etc.). However, it still contains a few controversial names.
